The competition will be held in Elva shooting range, Lasketiiru tee 1, Elva parish, Tartumaa, Estonia.

The competition is held between national teams and individual shooters.

Results and evaluation:

The winner in each event gets amount of points, which is equal to the number of participants in one of the events with maximum number of shooters.

The 2nd, 3rd and other places' points depend on number of shooters in the event.

There will be formula for each event to calculate points for each shooter.

P_x – points for shooter in place X

M – max quantity of shooters in one of the events = points for the 1st place in all events.

N – number of shooters in current event

S – value of step for current event

$S = M/N$ (number of shooters in one of the events' with max quantity of participants divided with number of shooters in current event).

Step will be calculated with hundredth (2 numbers after point).

$P_2 = M - S$

$P_3 = M - 2S$

$P_4 = M - 3S$

Value of the step in each event will be different, according to amount of participants in current event.



The last place in each event gets 1 point. National team's result consists of points collected from 20 shooters' points irrespective of event and sex.

The competition is an individual and the number of participants **is not limited**.

Each nation can start with unlimited number of shooters in each event, but only 3 shooters, appointed by 30th of May, collect points for the team.

After the competitions 20 best results of the competitors will be summed up and according to this the national ranking list will be published and the perpetually passed cup will be granted.

Participants must be born before the year 2005.

Rules:

The competition will be conducted in accordance with the ISSF Official Statutes, Rules and Regulations and ESC Statutes and General Regulations.

The competition organizing committee reserves the right to change the competition instructions, when the ISSF General Rules and Regulations are changed.

Shooting ranges:

The Elva shooting range is located at 2 km from Elva, 25 km from Tartu and approximately 215 km from [Tallinn International Airport](#).

Elva shooting complex has:

- 25 m shooting range, pistol cal .22LR: **6 groups with 5 targets**
- 50 m shooting range: **20 targets** – Sius electronic; **22 targets** paper targets
- 10m shooting range **8 targets** - Sius electronic targets
- 50m Running target shooting range: **1 device, 2 targets** – paper target

Entry fees:

Entry fees are individual/ per event **10 EURO**

Awards:

Victory medals for the 3 best shooters in each event and age category.

Best national team is awarded by the challenge cup – Baltic Cup.

Firearms and ammunition:

Travelling to Estonia from EU membership country requires only a **European Firearms passport**. Transportation of air weapons (.177) in Republic of Estonia is **without restrictions**. Participants, who do not have a European Firearms passport, need to fill annex 3 Firearm and Ammunition form.

Firearm and ammunition storage:

Gun storage for firearms, equipment and ammunition will be provided on the Elva shooting range. The shooters will not be allowed to carry their firearms to the hotel and camping rooms.
